## **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

It looks like we again will have a busy year ahead. The Mother's Day Fair is our next big activity and hopefully, you are all busy making pots to sell at the fair. Last year our membership grew to around 200 members and already many members have renewed their membership, so we should have a great selection of pottery for sale at the fair.

**Proposed Extension** - The majority of the Council requirements have at last been met and we will shortly be able to proceed with getting quotes and applying for funding for the extension which will house all the kilns in a purpose built area, together with an area at the front of the clubhouse where the clay will be stored, (instead of the shed) allowing easier access.

## **CLAYS AND MATERIALS**

Our January order from Picasso's Ceramics has still not left Brisbane due to problems with getting a transport company to deliver it. All the transport trucks are prioritised for food delivery to Far North. As soon as the club knows when it will be delivered, we will let you know. The club did manage to get its order from Walkers Ceramics so we have some spare Walkers 10, PB103 and SES earthenware – stoneware clays for sale.

## **SOCIAL FIRING**

To those who usually participate in our social firing, please keep the following points in mind.

- Please specify the type of clay and glaze. Social firing is for Stoneware only.
- If you are using your own glaze, please test it first.
- Use kiln biscuits if you are firing small pieces or fragile items to avoid the firing officers touching them directly.
- Fill out a firing form with similar products; for example, if you have a single tall vase along with mugs, please complete a separate firing order form, one for the vase and one for the mugs
- Please do not put more than 5 items per form
- Share shelf spaces with others.
- Avoid touching other members' greenware or glazed pots.

### ***Advanced Class: Throwing off the hump with Carole Lomax (Members only)***

This class focuses on advanced techniques, mainly throwing off the hump for both individual pieces and repetition production. Spiral kneading for large amounts of clay will also be taught, and basic forms will be revisited to refine and enhance throwing techniques.

Classes will be offered in 4-week blocks for **\$120**. Participants must provide their own clay and tools. Each session will run for **2 hours**, with only **4 places available** to ensure personalised guidance.

Participants must already be proficient in centering and raising clay.

## Lachlan Mackee

I am an emerging studio potter working out of a private studio in Bayview Heights. I work with stoneware and, more recently, forged clay. My work focuses on objects for use within the home, such as drinking vessels & interior design-focused pieces. While making, I aim to strike a balance between the looseness of form and contrasting mark-making. I choose to leave evidence of the making process in my work, helping connect the maker to the end user.

I am an avid wood firer and have the privilege to be mentored by the small but tight-knit community of North Queensland wood-firing potters. For 2025 I am part of the 'Foster A Potter' cohort and will be firing with Len Cook in Paluma.

I spent the majority of 2024 studying production pottery and wood-firing techniques at the incredible Golden Bridge Pottery in southern India. It was a life-changing experience in such a special place. The skills obtained during this time allowed me to transition from a fourteen-year career as a detective to that of a working artist. I established Service Ceramics to continue to serve the community, only now with objects I make. My journey in India will be chronicled in an upcoming issue of the Journal of Australian Ceramics.

I have fired Anagama kilns in three countries and will spend the majority of 2025 and onwards seeking further opportunities to do so, as I deepen my understanding of how these kilns work and chase my curiosity with the surfaces and marks they produce on my work.

2025 will also be a transition year for me as I intend to move to the Atherton Tablelands and establish my own kiln. With the view of running wood-firing workshops for the local ceramic community. More information can be found on my links below or by getting in touch at
