Friday 29 August will become the property of the Cairns Show Association—unless other arrangements have been made before the show ends.


Set up of Display: Any members wishing to assist with the setting up of the display of the 3D section please ring Chris. George 40532240.

Hand Building Workshop - 2ND AUGUST

Discover the joys of making pots with a variety of successful techniques. You will be working with various clays and learn what is the best fit of the clay body for each project.

Explore the process of making functional as well as decorative pieces. How to pattern to add texture and depth, what is sgraffito, and tips to join and shape. The skill will provide a grounding for your independent works in clay.

Sculpture Workshop - 30TH AUGUST

Join me for a full day immersive experience where you will learn the art of sculpting a magical dragon, inspired by your imagination. Explore the techniques and principles of working with clay to make a 3-dimensional project. I will discuss and demonstrate various making processes, the firing cycle for sculpture and the finishing technique for your dragon. This workshop is suitable for most people, as you don't require previous experience.

CLASSES AT THE CLUB

Advanced Wheel Throwing Classes with Carole Lomax (Members Only) *Expression of Interest and restating interest (Tentative starting date: 10 July)*

This class focuses on advanced techniques, including throwing off the hump for both individual pieces and repetition production. Spiral kneading for large amounts of clay will also be taught, and basic forms will be revisited to refine and enhance throwing techniques.

Classes will be offered in 4-week blocks at a cost of \$140. Participants must provide their own clay and tools. Each session will run for 2 hours, with only 4 places available to ensure personalised guidance. Participants must already be proficient in centring and raising clay.

SHELVES AWARENESS!

Please make sure you're putting your ceramic work on the *right* shelf (not just the one closest to your arm's reach). Look for the labels under each shelf to know what goes where. Here's the breakdown:

- **Drying shelves** – label your work clearly with your name and date. (Work in progress form)
- **Bisque firing shelves** – for bone dry greenware ready to be fired.
- **Glaze firing shelves** – for bisque pieces that are glazed and ready for their final firing
- **Collection shelves** – for picking up your finished bisque or glaze-fired work.

Carolyn Brumby – NORTH QUEENSLAND POTTER/SCULPTER

I have worked and created with clay for many years in North Queensland. I enjoy creating in this medium, generating surfaces that flow in many forms and colour. I love the way the curves glide, its endless forms and the tactile interaction. I create by wheel, hand-built and sculpture items. There is my functional ware to consume and enjoy each day. My decorative pots for your eyes to feast on, as your place in that special spot. While we touch and feel the creations, emotions are enhanced and allows the imagination to develop.

I began my journey in country towns in Queensland, where there were Pottery Clubs. When in Mackay, I invested in my first gas kiln. I was then based in Charters Towers for many years and finally had my own studio and another gas kiln. Thus I made reduction glazes.

In 2021, Charters Towers community had a sculpture project, where 11 life-size statues were made by artists, including myself for the town. This was under the guidance of Janna Pameijer. An amazing experience that sparked my enthusiasm in sculpture. I find making 3-dimensional sculptural forms are both challenging and rewarding. The skills required are a different set to make the end product.

There is a satisfying feeling when creating with your hands.

Since moving to Cairns, 3 years ago, I now fire in an electric kiln. My new glazes lend themselves to change and exploration. Crystalline is wonderful in its growth and colour. Gold lustres applied to the glazed pot for a third firing, adds another depth of colour. I reflect on the natural world to sync and be inspired in glaze colours. My aim is to make works that speak for themselves.
