SATURDAY, 6TH DECEMBER

Join us for our Christmas Fair from **8 am to 2pm**—we hope you'll have plenty of pots ready to sell!

Set-Up: Arrive by **7 am** to set up and secure a good spot.

What You Can Sell: While pottery is the focus, you're welcome to sell other items too—such as glasswork, paintings, jewelry, plants, or fruit.

Stall holders must be a financial member as of 30 NOV



Sales Details:

- Sales Sheet: You must complete a sales sheet with your name, contact details, and a list of all your items for sale. You can pick one up from the clubhouse, club's website or request it to be sent to you. <https://cairnsottersclub.com/club-forms/>
- Labelling: Each item must have a sticker with your initials, item number, and price.
- Drop Off: Hand in your sales sheet at the sales table when you arrive.
- Commission: The club takes a 20% commission on all sales.

During the Fair: You don't have to stay with your items, but being there helps promote your work. The club isn't responsible for unattended items. Purchases will be processed at the sales table. If you can, lend a hand during the day.

After the Fair: The Fair wraps up at 2 pm, so please return to pack up any unsold items. It would also be a big help if you could assist with cleaning up the grounds. **Packing up must start after 2 pm.**

Other Ways to Get Involved: If you don't have items to sell, we'd still love to have you! Come along, meet other potters, and help out for a few hours—it's a great way to stay connected. We'll also need volunteers for clay play activities with children during the day and some to demonstrate how to throw pots on the electric wheels. Parking: On arrival at the markets, please unload all your goods at your stall site. Vehicles must be removed from pedestrian walkways immediately after unloading. - Market stalls should be set up after the removal of your car.



11 October — 24 December 2025



Intimate Worlds brings together NorthSite makers whose practices are grounded in material exploration, slow processes, and thoughtful making. This exhibition highlights the space where art and design overlap—showcasing creators who work with sensitivity to their chosen materials and an enduring drive to test their potential.

Often working quietly and independently in their own studios, these five artists are given the opportunity to expand techniques in their chosen craft—creating objects that speak of inner worlds translated through form. The exhibition invites audiences into these practices, where craftsmanship and concept intertwine, and where each piece carries traces of time, care, and transformation.

At its core, **Intimate Worlds** is a celebration of experimental materiality and process. The artists' respect for their mediums, paired with a restless curiosity, results in works that resonate with both refinement and intimacy.


Wendy Moore
