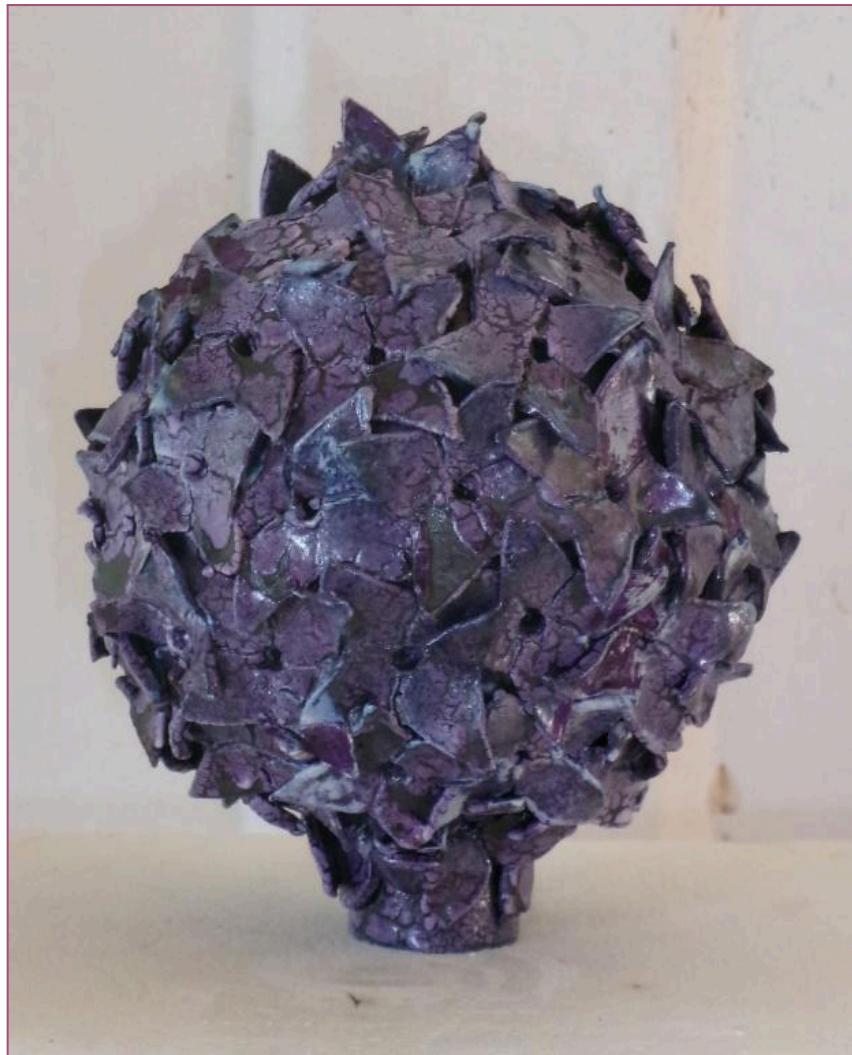

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Pottery certainly continued to grow in popularity here in Far North Queensland throughout 2025. Our membership reached 246 – the highest it has ever been. Our annual Christmas Fair, held on the first Saturday in December from 8 am to 2 pm, was a standout event, with more than \$21,000 worth of pottery sold. This was a record for the club and was made possible by the 36 stallholders who offered such a vibrant variety of colourful and diverse work to the public.

Looking ahead to 2026, it promises to be another busy year for the club. Alongside our usual Cairns Show ceramics display in July, we will also be hosting our biannual national ceramics exhibition, **MELTING POT 2026**, planned for the second half of the year. Hopefully you are already beginning to make your masterpieces for these upcoming exhibitions.

WORKSHOPS AND CLASSES


Hand Building Workshop - Carolyn Brumby

Intermediate Wheel Throwing Classes - Carole Lomax (Members Only)

Tentative start date: early February


These intermediate wheel throwing classes offer an opportunity to deepen your relationship with the clay and refine the quiet skills that come with practice. The tentative start date is early February, with the final date to be confirmed once sufficient expressions of interest have been received.

The focus will be on advanced throwing techniques, including throwing off the hump for both individual pieces and repeated forms. You'll also learn spiral kneading for preparing larger amounts of clay, and revisit essential forms with fresh attention—refining movement, control, and consistency at the wheel.

Classes are offered in 4-week blocks, with 2-hour sessions at a cost of \$140. A minimum of four participants is required for the class to run, with a maximum of six participants, allowing for thoughtful, personalised guidance. Participants should already be confident in centering and raising clay. Please bring your own clay and tools.

I have been working with clay and glazes since 1978, exploring a wide range of techniques – from primitive forming and firing methods to the use of modern materials and specialised firing schedules. Functional ware has never held much appeal for me. Instead, my work is inspired by the tropical environment and the impressions gained through extensive world travel.

Over the years, I have experimented with many glaze types, including bronze, crystalline, crawling and, more recently, chrome glazes. These have featured in my series of rainforest forms, and I am currently creating works inspired by ginger plants (*Etlingera*) and their flower blossoms. I am enjoying exploring these forms using vibrant, colourful glazes and continuing to have a great deal of fun in the process.
